

INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

Fondazione Venezia Servizi alla Persona, as data controller of personal data (hereinafter "Fondazione Venezia"), releases the following information in compliance with European and Italian regulations on the protection of personal data.

Fondazione Venezia has appointed a data protection officer (DPO), who can be contacted by writing to the following address: dpo@fondazioneveneziaservizi.it.

Purpose and legal basis of the processing

If you sign up for this service, Fondazione Venezia will process the personal data collected to send the newsletter via e-mail containing promotions, invitations to events, information on organized exhibitions, greeting messages and similar communications. Consent is not required because the processing is necessary for the provision of the service.

Data retention period

Fondazione Venezia will process the data until the termination of the service or any request for unsubscription, whichever is earlier.

Nature of providing data and consequences in case of refusal

The provision of data is optional, but the refusal to communicate it will make it impossible to register for this service.

Scope of data communication and categories of recipients

Fondazione Venezia will not disseminate the data, which will be communicated exclusively to internal figures authorized to process them based on their respective duties, as well as to professionals, companies or other third parties who carry out outsourced activities and who are therefore appointed as data controllers with a specific contract or other deed. legal.

Data transfer to a third country and/or an international organization

Fondazione Venezia uses some cloud computing services which may involve data processing through servers or IT equipment located outside the European Economic Area. In all these cases, the transfers will be carried out in compliance with the specific provisions established by the regulations regarding the protection of personal data: in particular, the transfers will take place on the basis of adequacy decisions of the European Commission.

Rights of interested parties

The subject to whom the personal data refers (hereinafter "Interested Party") has the right to unsubscribe from this service at any time and may also ask Fondazione Venezia to access their personal data and to rectify them if inaccurate, to delete them or limit its processing, as well as obtain its portability.
